## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ADMISSION NEET PG-2020 FIRST ROUND OF COUNSELING

- 1. Candidate has to login with his/her roll number and registered email-id to view the allotment result on the website - https://upneet.gov.in.
- 2. Candidate will be provided a button of <pay tuition fee> to submit *online tuition* fee at the page of allotment result. Candidate has to pay Rs. 30,000/- (Rs. Thirty thousand only) in case he/she has been allotted seat of Government Institutions. If the candidate has been allotted seat of private institution, he/she has to pay Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs.Two lacs only) for MDS Courses or Rs. 10,000,00/- (Rs.Ten lacs only) for MD/MS (Clinical) Courses and Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rs.Five lacs only) for MD/MS (Non Clinical Pre and Para Medical) Courses.
- 3. After submitting the tuition fee, candidate will be enabled to download tuition fee receipt and allotment letter.
- 4. Candidate has to report at designated Nodal Centre with receipts, allotment letter and other related documents in person (off-line) if there is no restriction on the movement by the local administration.
- 5. If there is restriction on the movement by local administration, Candidate has to report on-line through email his/her tuition fee receipts, allotment letter, MCI/DCI registration certificate, MBBS/BDS degree, relevant reservation certificates and ID, to the email-id of the Nodal Centre as shown in the allotment letter.
- 6. Nodal Centre has been provided an interface to verify the details of the candidate and submit the button in order to complete his/her reporting formalities. If candidate is reporting in person, the Nodal centre can complete this activity in the presence of the candidate immediately.
- 7. In order to complete the reporting formalities for all those students who have sent their tuition fee receipts, allotment letter and other related documents in the emails. Nodal Centre must check their email regularly at certain intervals and complete the formalities of the reporting of the students. Nodal Centre must also reply all those students through e-mail if there is any shortcoming in the documents.
- 8. Nodal Centres compulsorily do the verification and submit the button for reporting of the students failing which reporting procedure of the candidate will not complete.
- 9. All allotted candidates have to complete their admission process from 04-05-2020 (4:00PM) to 09-05-2020.
